

License & Compact Status Acknowledgment



Declaration of Residency and Licensure

If you intend to practice using a compact (multi-state) license, you must adhere to the policies set forth by that profession's licensure compact. When your Primary State of Residence (PSOR) or permanent residence* is in a compact state, you may be eligible for compact licensure in that state, which allows you to practice using that license in all other participating compact states within that profession. Your PSOR is the state where you hold a current driver's license, voter's card, federal income tax return, military form 2058 or W-2 form. You may only hold one PSOR at a time.

If the state your PSOR documents are issued in does not match your compact license state, you may be required to apply for/obtain appropriate licensure or update your residency documents prior to starting your Aya assignment. We follow the guidelines set forth by each compact to ensure you are not at risk of losing your compact license status.
